

Lifetime Achievement award to Raja Ramanna

BANGALORE, DHNS: The Bangalore Management Association conferred Lifetime Achievement Award, posthumously, on Dr Raja Ramanna who passed away last week in Mumbai.

The award was received by Dr Ramanna's wife Mamata Raja Ramanna at a function organised in Bangalore on Tuesday evening. Dr Ramanna himself was scheduled to receive the award.

Dr Ramanna's daughter Nina Kanjirath shared her experiences she had with her father. Calling him a 'great traveller', Nina said he had promised his wife during his last visit to Mumbai that he would personally collect the award and that he would no longer move around after that. "But it is unfortunate that he is not there. We as a family will miss him, but are comforted by the fact that he has done so much for the country and that the country would miss him", said. Nina even called him a 'Gypsy' for his fondness for travelling.

Former Chief Justice of India M N Venkatachalaiah recalled his association with the

nuclear physicist and said the two often travelled together on flights, especially between Bangalore and New Delhi. "It is impossible to estimate the magnitude of the loss", he said.
