

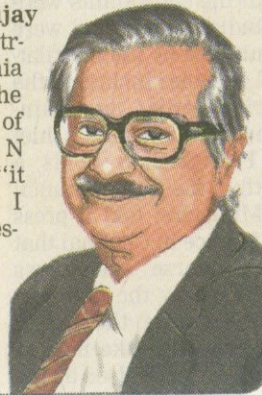
Fate denies Raja Ramanna 'Life time award'
